### **PURPOSE:**

Jakarta Intercultural School (JIS) educators provide memorable experiences for JIS students. JIS educators work in a professional learning community to continuously improve teaching practice for the benefit of the students at JIS in pursuit of our *Mission*, *Vision*, *Values*, *and Dispositions*.

The Middle School (MS) Teacher will teach visual and performing arts classes as part of the exploratory/ elective program. These classes are taught in 75-minute blocks on alternate days. During the 6th and 7th grades, students are placed in movement, drama, vocal music, or visual arts classes; during 8th grade, students "elect" the classes of their choice. These classes run for one quarter in the 6th grade and a semester during the 7th and 8th grades.

The visual arts at JIS middle school is an inquiry and media base program that offers printmaking, painting, and sculpture (focus on ceramics) for grades 6 through 8. Students possess a great deal of voice and choice into what they create guided by the National Core Art Standards. Drawing is a basic component in each course and is developed vertically throughout the MS Art curriculum.

Middle School adolescents are at the ideal stage for developing their visual awareness. The Visual Arts program's goal is to provide them with the foundational skills required to successfully express their thoughts and feelings through the art-making process.
