### 📀 Vision

Our school's vision is to exceed the needs of every student in every classroom every day. We believe this perfectly aligns with the Shawnee Mission School District's strategic plan objective that each student will have a personalized learning plan that will prepare them for college and careers, with the interpersonal skills they need for life success. The 2019-20 and 2020-21 school years have presented many unprecedented challenges, and our staff, students and families have adapted to significant changes in instruction and learning. Having 1:1 technology for all students and teachers allowed us to tackle these challenges and connect with one another very successfully. We were able to maintain very positive student-teacher relationships throughout this period, as evidenced by our 85% positive score on the Panorama social emotional learning survey.

Trailwood students are met where they are with regard to skills and knowledge, and they are encouraged to improve and grow from there. Whether not yet mastering grade level standards or excelling beyond the grade level, students are encouraged with high expectations to continue their learning. Teachers in 6th grade provide timely, colorcoded digital feedback on student writing. 4th grade students are enriched by creating Pixton graphic novels with a focus on figurative language. And kindergarten students use ChatterPix to explain their learning in creative ways.




# **7** Success
