#### Maths

Our maths topic in term 1 will be place value. This will involve the children applying their fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills across a variety of activities. English

Our core text this term will be 'Macbeth.' We will be exploring the themes of the Shakespeare tragedy and the complex relationships within the play whilst beginning to understand the language of Shakespeare.

### Wider Curriculum

We will be looking at the movement of people and trade across the world and the impact that this has on the environment.

## **Uniform**
