The school has introduced a new intuitive and easy to use online appointment booking system ('School Cloud'). You will be able to make appointments with your child's subject teachers via the School Cloud platform from **4.00pm on Thursday 2nd December until 10am on Thursday 9th December**; please see the attached sheet for instructions on how to create an account and make these appointments, there is also a link to a short video demonstrating the process. **It is important to note that each appointment is limited to 5 minutes and will automatically end at the end of this time.**
