



STEMCivics Gifted and Talented Program

Opportunities for Gifted Education

For eligible grade 6-8 students, STEMCivics awards opportunities for students to enroll in accelerated general education courses. In grades 9-12, honors level courses, advanced placement, and dual enrollment college courses are available.

Referral Process

Students are evaluated annually and given opportunities to enroll for the following year.

1. Students and parents can submit requests via counselors or grade level deans.
2. Teachers, deans, counselors, and administrators are also given an opportunity to submit recommendations.
3. A Gifted and Talented Program Recommendation Form is shared to collect relevant criteria.
4. Acceptance into G&T courses are based on student grades, self-motivation, ability to work independently, critical thinking skills, time management, and organizational skills. Students do not need to meet all of the criteria, but should possess the majority of requirements.

Enrollment Process

1. Accepted students and parents/guardians will receive email notification.
2. The school counselor will review possible courses with the family and schedule in the student information system.

Appeals Process
