Western Culture and Social Dynamics is a UC A-G credit-bearing Elective course that provides students a classroom setting in which they engage in an interdisciplinary study of topics. Students will have the unique experience of expanding on classroom lessons through co-curricular opportunities around Southern California which will broaden the experience and allow for real-world applications through the Christian worldview.

This immersion course is required for incoming international students and takes place on Saturdays. There are 8 classes in the Fall semester and 8 classes in the Spring semester.
