School Performance: Three Year Trend-SPS Based on Teche Elementary LEAP Scores

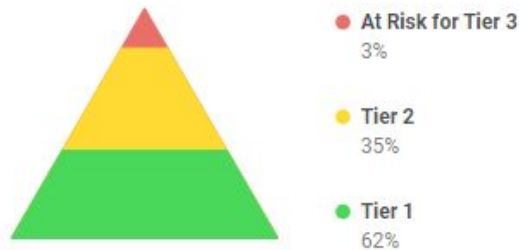

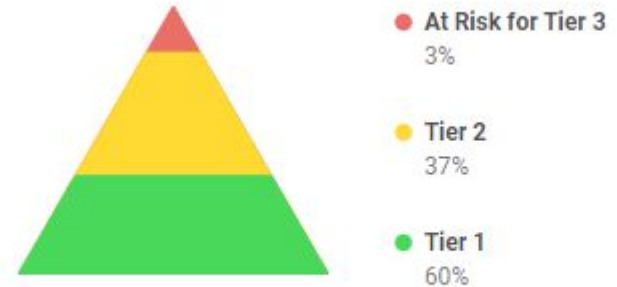

School Performance: iReady Achievement Levels

iReady is divided by three levels of achievement. Our goal is for every student to reach “Green” which signals readiness for the next grade level. We ended 20-21 with about 60% in green for Reading and Math.

2021-2022 School Improvement Goals and Priorities

Given the data we've shared, **Cecilia Primary** is focused on the following priorities for the 2021-2022 school year:

- On the Spring 2022 IReady Reading Assessment, 70% of the students enrolled at Cecilia Primary will increase their overall scale score by reaching their typical growth and be on or above benchmark level (in the green).
- On the Spring 2022 IReady Math Assessment, 70% of the students enrolled at Cecilia Primary will increase their overall scale score by reaching their typical growth and be on or above benchmark level (in the green).



School Improvement Plan Implementation Timeline

Here is our timeline for attaining the goals outlined in our school's improvement plan.

Timeframe	Activity
Spring-Summer 2021	High quality professional development for all teachers on the Tier I curriculum and Data Driven Instruction.
Fall 2021	--Data driven instruction--analyzing and utilizing weekly data to intentionally plan for individual student needs --Response to Intervention --Weekly PLC'sbased on needs to build teacher effectiveness and improve student growth
Winter 2022	--same as above --at least 70% towards our goals as evidenced by Interim Assessment data
Spring 2022	--same as above --100% mastery of our goals as evidenced by iReady EOY Assessment data
