

Rhetoric 101 and 102 Dual Credit Enrollment Checklist

Prerequisites:

- Students must be in academic good standing. Students who have taken a JJC class prior to this time and has received a “D” or an “F” are not eligible to enroll in district dual credit classes.
- It is strongly suggested that students meet with their high school counselor to discuss their academic schedule and review NCAA eligibility and transfer credit options where applicable.
- Students must successfully complete English 3.
- Students must achieve one of the following: An SAT English and reading score (ERW) of 480 or higher, an ACT English score of 19 or higher, or complete placement testing using the ACCUPLACER program (Reading: 246 or higher, Writing: 5 or higher).

Requirements:

- Apply to JJC online (the application process is easy and free).

- Verify placement scores or take ACCUPLACER placement exam; submit a copy of results to counselor (students can use spring SAT score to qualify).
