

AMSA Policy for Travel During Covid

CDC recommends delay all travel until fully vaccinated against Covid 19

For any travel please self-monitor for Covid 19 symptoms during your travel and 14 days after your travel. Isolate and get tested if you develop symptoms.

Domestic (State to State within US) Travel:

- Monitor for signs and symptoms of Covid 19 for 14 days after travel

International Travel: Depends on whether your child is immunized or not.

- Please follow the CDC guidelines in the chart below.
- Call/email Maureen Searl, RN @ 508-597-2475/msearl@amsacs.org to report your travel destination, departure, and arrival dates.
- Nurse Searl will establish the date for the 3–5-day testing at school
 - Be sure you have completed the Consent form for BinaxNow testing
 - **Students that are vaccinated:**
 - May return to school but must clear through the health office prior to entering any school buildings.
 - Must have a consent form for testing on file
 - Will be tested at school 3-5 days after return.
 - **Students that are not vaccinated**
 - Are required to be quarantined. Parents will work with Nurse Searl to establish dates
 - Students not vaccinated that must quarantine are eligible for zooming in.

Get tested 1-3 days before traveling out of the US	✓	
Mandatory test required before flying to US	✓	✓
Get tested 3-5 days after travel	✓	✓
Self-quarantine after travel for 7 days with a negative test or 10 days without test	✓	
Self-monitor for symptoms	✓	✓
Wear a mask and take other precautions during travel	✓	✓
