

# Vaccination Mandate Information

## Contingent on Full FDA Approval\*

\*Not Emergency Use Authorization





## **Applies to**

#### All students in K-12 in

- Public
- Charter
- Private and
- All School Employees

COVID-19 vaccine will be among roster of 10 other vaccinations that state requires students receive before starting school.

Students who opt out <u>will not</u> be allowed to attend school in person; can enroll in independent study.



- Ages 12+
   Corresponding with grades 7-12
- Ages 5-11
   Corresponding with grades K-6

Students who are under age of full approval, but within the grade span will be required to vaccinate once they reach age of full approval.



Requirement takes effect at start of (academic) term following <u>full approval</u> of that grade span.

To be defined as

January 1, 2022

Or

July 1, 2022

whichever comes first

Local health jurisdictions and LEAs are encouraged to implement requirements ahead of the state requirement based on local circumstances.

### **Exemptions**

Medical, Religious and Personal\*\*

\*\*Because mandate comes from governor and not the Legislature
