Kings Canyon Adult School offers classes for adults and high school students who have attained senior status. Most classes are held in the evenings, Monday through Thursday. A few classes are offered in the morning and afternoon. Classes are offered in Reedley, Orange Cove and Dunlap. The adult program offers high school diploma classes, English as a Second Language, Adult Basic Education, Vocational and Career Technical Education classes. Adult Independent Study is also available.

Educational Philosophy

Kings Canyon Educational Options utilizes a student-centered educational philosophy that emphasizes the uniqueness and potential of each individual student, capitalizes on an excellent and caring staff, offers a diverse listing of classes, provides a number of diploma options, and encourages the pursuit of higher education and training after the high school diploma.

ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

Kings Canyon Adult School provides the following programs:

- * Adult Secondary Education (ASE)
- * English as a Second Language (ESL)
- * Career and Technical Education (CTE)

ADMISSION

All adults 18 years of age and over may register for classes regardless of residence. Students with senior status enrolled in high school must have written permission from their high school counselor to take adult school classes for credit. Adults have first priority. We also offer services to high school juniors for remediation/credit recovery who have had no disciplinary infractions at their comprehensive high school.

There is no tuition cost or registration fee to enroll in adult school. Small fees may apply to vocational training classes.

All Kings Canyon Adult School students enrolling in the ABE, ASE, and ESL programs are required to test prior to placement and upon completion of their semester.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Concurrent high school students and parent/guardian must have a counseling session with their high school counselor and must have the concurrent enrollment form filled out completely before registration.

ADULT INDEPENDENT STUDY

Various high school subjects are offered to adults through our independent study program. All courses count toward graduation requirements.

How to register for High School Courses:

- ◆ Register and take a placement test at the Adult School office.
- ◆ Bring official high school transcript from the last high school attended.
- ◆ Must see a counselor before a teacher is assigned.
- ◆ Attend a mandatory orientation meeting. Mandatory meetings are held twice per month. Call our office for more information.

High school credits previously earned can be applied towards the 190 total credits. Students must earn 10 credits through Kings Canyon Adult School as part of the 190 credits requirement for graduation. Students must attain satisfactory attendance and not have more than two absences to receive credit in a class. **All high school diploma applications must be submitted to our office by March 31, 2022.**

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

ADULT INDEPENDENT STUDY

Various high school subjects are offered to adults through our independent study program. All courses count toward graduation requirements. Class times vary from morning, afternoon, and evening. Weekly meetings with teachers are required.
