

San Diego County Office of Education (SDCOE) PASS AmeriCorps



Member Duties: Implement prevention/intervention case-management for 30 identified at-risk youth (3-12 graders) in partnering schools; students referred by school team and enrolled by member; member provides academic support (tutoring, organize backpack/binder, in-class work, homework help); mentoring 1:1-3 sessions weekly or more, group discussions & service learning opportunities throughout school year. 39 PASS AmeriCorps members are assigned individually or in pairs to one of 29 partnering schools in Oceanside, San Marcos, Vista, Valley Center or San Diego; responsible for implementing PASS model, collect/maintain student records/data, facilitate parent outreach & organize activities for Nat'l Days of Service; members receive extensive Orientation, ongoing professional development on relevant topics to service, weekly/monthly team meetings, weekly on-site coaching from program supervisor; full-time only, 11-month commitment, 1700 min hours, serving M-F during school hours (8.5+hrs/day); additional hour per week for mandatory team meeting; some mandatory weeknights & weekend days/nights.

Program Benefits: School Loan Deferment, Education Award of \$5,815 upon successful completion of Term of Service; MEC Health Benefits; fixed monthly living allowance, childcare benefits, ongoing professional development, coaching/support, additional trainings; letters of reference; serving a PLUS on your resume.

Terms (required): Meet all Eligibility & Background Requirements; have own car, valid CA Driver's License and Car Insurance; agree to member contract commitment.

Program goals are designed to engage participating students in meaningful mentoring relationships that help them realize their dreams through experiencing academic success, making healthy choices, and developing positive leadership roles at school and in the community. Applicants selected to serve must meet all AmeriCorps and SDCOE PASS eligibility requirements and conditions to serve in program.
