- Exams will occur in the regularly scheduled classroom for each course schedule above.
- Each examination period is two hours in length and begins at the time designated at the top of each column above. To accommodate students who may be sharing computers with family members or have internet connectivity issues, instructors of online courses may wish to **provide a 24-hour period, concluding at the end of their final exam time, for students to begin an exam.** It is recommended, however, that once students begin their exam that they have no more than two hours to complete it (except in cases of accommodations resulting from ADA).
- The following courses do not have final exam times set in the schedule above: all courses that were designated online; courses meeting at locations other than the Brunswick campus and the Camden Center; and courses with prefixes JOUR, CCGA and PHED activity courses, support classes, science labs. Examinations for these courses will be at a time set by the instructor and approved by the appropriate Dean.
