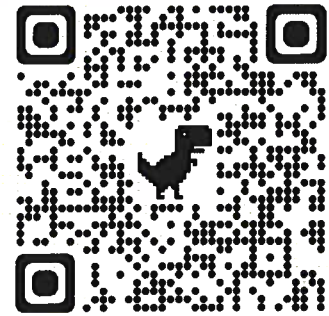
In my free time I love to play competitive video games and play with my animals, I have four cats' ages 4-21 years old.
