OIL IN EQUIPMENT

Please make sure you are checking the engine oil in your equipment. If you have a Billy Goat, please check the oil before every use. If you have a problem, please call in a work order at 801-402-5600.

ICE MELT

When using ice melt, please adhere to the manufacturer's recommendation for application in the picture below.

- Do not put ice melt in parking lots or playgrounds. Our budgets cannot accommodate this much use of ice melt.
- Apply the ice melt to critical walking areas only. Apply every 20 minutes as needed.
- Keep track of the ice melt used. A form on our website is available to help with this.
- Over Applying prevents the product from working correctly.
