

Christmas Mass Schedule: Prior to 2016, the two early Christmas Eve Masses were ticketed only to School and CCF families, and there were overflow Masses in DeSales Hall. In 2017, we opened up the Masses to all parishioners and added an additional Christmas Eve Mass. However, because of the significant demand to attend these Masses, signup was still required for every person, and there were no overflow Masses. The church and parking lot have limited capacity per Mass. In 2019, we did not have a ticket system, which proved NOT to be a success. The number of people in the Church was over capacity limits, and getting into and out of Mass was highly unsafe in the Narthex and in the parking lot. During COVID, we used SignUpGenius for signing up for Mass, and it went exceptionally well, so we will be using that process again this year. Signup will be on a first-come, first-served basis for ALL Masses. The link to signup will be sent to all parishioners, and will go live on Dec. 13th at 9 am.

Construction Update: Work on the bell tower is progressing, however as with any construction project when you open a wall... Rust was found on the steel beams and work is being done to seal the beams. Once this is completed the brickwork will continue. In order for a more structurally sound bell tower, the façade of the tower will slightly change. The four columns will have a more finished look and this design will allow for expansion and contraction of the structure. During this time, the crew also had

the opportunity to begin the exterior brickwork of the church and will continue as long as weather permits. Interior work is still planned for after Christmas. The bell tower work will occur and the circle will be closed to traffic but the sidewalks will be accessible. The bells and lights have been turned off during the project. <u>Updates will be provided on the website</u>.

Traffic changes near Fr. Brisson Gym Due to basketball season, the road in front of the gym is closed to traffic. Since children's safety continues to be our number one priority, this change will allow the students to walk from their cars to the gym. We ask that you use the Niblick Road and main Wolftrap Road entrance for attending Mass, CCF class, or other events on campus, instead of the back Wolftrap/Notre Dame entrance. Using these main entrances will lessen the number of cars that drive through the campus near the gym. The gym parking lot is still accessible. Thank you for your cooperation.


