THE MISSION OF CCSA FOUNDATION is to support Chester Charter Scholars Academy, an arts-integrated, K-12, public charter school serving children from the Chester Upland School District.

Thank you for your support of CCSA and your help in creating a vibrant future for Chester's youth. It is an honor to be associated with such an impactful program and to work with so many dedicated and generous donors.

Statistics do not tell the whole story but here are a few that reflect the level of engagement at CCSA:

- 98.5% graduation rate for our first three senior classes (139 of 141 students)
- 91% student daily attendance rate
- 780+ on current wait-list

Since our founding, CCSA has stayed true to its vision that "CCSA graduates will be prepared for college, conservatory, technical school, the military or gainful employment." One hundred percent of our first three senior classes were admitted to a community college or a four-year college/university! Our arts-integrated curriculum and our focus on developing scholarship, strong character, craftsmanship and purpose have played an important role in the success of our students.

CCSA is a great example "it takes a village to raise a child". None of the above would be possible without your help and support. You have enabled CCSA to offer academic and career opportunities to the children of Chester not otherwise available in the district.

I hope you share my pride in what has been accomplished to date. However, the challenge continues and we look forward to working together to provide a quality education for our students.

THE CCSA FUND

sustains essential educational opportunities for CCSA scholars in grades K-12.

In fiscal year 2021, **440 donors** contributed **\$1 million** to the CCSA Fund, helping to provide a clear path to success for our students.

The CCSA Difference:

FISCAL YEAR 2021 (JULY 2020- JUNE 2021)

Incoming kindergartners receive **96 hours** of enrichment programming before **DAY ONE** of the academic year.

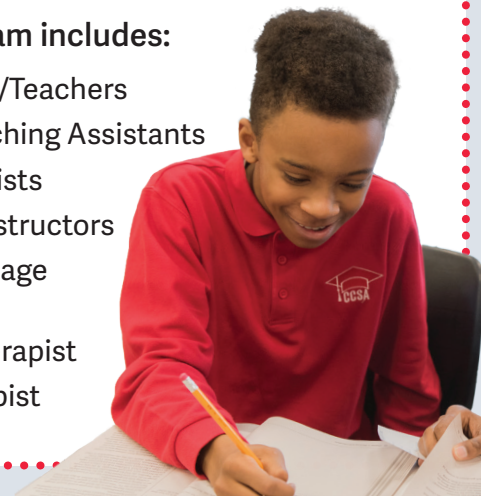
Our six-week summer program introduces classroom routines, allows our teachers to make valuable assessments and helps build student confidence – all so our youngest learners can hit the ground running at the start of the school year.



Currently **139 students** receive individualized support.

All 695 students in grades K-12 benefit from CCSA's curriculum-wide arts-integrated model.

- All students study visual art, instrumental music, vocal music, theatre, and dance and receive five hours of arts instruction weekly.
- Our core subject and arts teachers collaborate to develop lessons that use artistic disciplines to engage students.
- Community partnerships enhance our curriculum and include: ArtSmart, Community Arts Center in Wallingford, Darlington Arts, Greener Partners, Players Club of Swarthmore, Tyler Arboretum, and West Chester University Department of Theatre and Dance.



100% of CCSA graduates set a strong example for students who follow in their footsteps.

We celebrate these
accomplishments of
CCSA's Class of 2021:

- 100% applied and were accepted to a 2- or 4-year school.
- All 49 Seniors submitted a total of 299 applications to 81 different colleges and universities (*an average of 6 applications per student.*)
- The senior class received 237 college acceptances, achieving a 79% acceptance rate.
- Over \$687,000 in scholarship funds were awarded to the Class of 2021.

The school stands as a source of pride for the City of Chester, reflecting the beauty of our children."

Currently, Tamia is thriving as a third year nursing student at Neumann University. She returned to CCSA as a teaching assistant in our summer program.

"I am grateful for the life lessons I learned at CCSA, most of all my sense of optimism," Tamia shared. "Before I graduated, I realized that everything that I did would have an impact on my future. My teachers and family taught me to never doubt myself, and because of this, I believe I will be successful in all I endeavor."
