- Covid-19 Protocols and Updates

Shelly Weber went over what has been done from beginning to provide policy and put procedures in place.

 - Guidance and guidelines from CDC, DSHS, AAP, and Dr. Charles Laurence –Health Authority.
 - Kimberly Brents went over protocols for COVID-19. The campuses are making sure criteria is met. With the coming of flu season, it will be hard to distinguish between the two. The District is practicing 6’ social distancing when feasible, the use of masks or face shields as approved by principal, the use of hand sanitizers. For a student to return to school per Covid protocol, he/she must be out 10 days, be fever-free for 24 hours and have improvement of symptoms. A student could return sooner with an alternative diagnosis from a physician or a negative PCR test. Buses are cleaned between routes and deep cleaned. Also mentioned Shelly Weber does a great job at health care provider. No transmissions of COVID-19 in school.
- Senate Bill 435, Opioid Education Updates
 - Law reads for SHAC to offer instruction /education between school district and communities regarding opioids. More guidance with be provided by the State in February.
- Flu Shot Clinics for Staff and Students
 - Social distancing may decrease flu numbers
 - Flu shots offered to staff and students. Health Heros will offer the shots to students. No out of pocket fees.
