Meeting Minutes from 2-8-2021

The minutes were accepted as written

SB 435—Opioid Abuse/Prevention/Antagonist Instruction

The TSHAC was scheduled to meet in February to discuss and finalize the recommendations for school districts regarding opioid abuse/prevention/ antagonist instruction in the schools. However, due to the winter storm, the group did not meet until the end of March. The recommendations have not been released yet. We will push this agenda item until the start of the next school year. At the beginning of next school year, we will form a subcommittee to work on this agenda item.

Covid-19 District Updates and Survey

The district has had a drastic decrease in the number of Covid-19 positive staff members and students. The district will survey parents about interest in virtual and face-to-face learning options. The district would also like to have some feedback about masking. LISD will continue the mask mandate for the rest of the school year. At this time, the district is not tracking those that are vaccinated. The Covid vaccine is not required. There have been numerous vaccine clinics in Lockhart. Anyone that wants a vaccine has had the opportunity to get a vaccine. The district will be following CDC and TEA guidelines for vaccinated individuals who have a close contact with a Covid-19 positive person.

Wellness Policy Updates

Board Policy FFA Local outlines our district Wellness Policy. Every 3 years, the district is supposed to perform a self-assessment to evaluate school compliance and progress towards attaining goals in the wellness policy. The SHAC will need to develop a wellness plan describing how the policies will be implemented in the school environment. TASB has a template for the wellness plan. We will form a subcommittee to work on this task next school year.
