We've concluded our first week of the second quarter. It's been a week of highs and lows. Those of us that attended the fall band concert were treated to the wonderful musicianship of our varsity and concert bands. It was a joy to be gathered together in the gymnasium for the first time in my time here and over two years!

We also experienced the loss of one of our current staff members, Monica Luckett. We were fortunate to know her as a loyal substitute teacher, dedicated part-time staff member, and supporter of Rockford schools. I would like to thank our incredible counseling team from REAMS, RMS-CES, and RHS for their help and support as students processed their grief. It's another example of how our district uses the most of our resources to help enhance the student experience. We continue to hold the Luckett family in our hearts for the coming weeks.

As we continue through the second quarter, please continue to monitor your student's progress. I've been observing classrooms and there are variable levels of student motivation during work time. One of the main benefits of a block schedule (we run a modified block) is the ability to get work done at the end of the class period. Please continue to check Infinite Campus Parent Portal for grading information, be mindful of the workload and study habits of your child/ren and, most importantly, dialogue with your child/ren about their progress in class. We have a number of resources available to assist students: Homework Help every Wednesday after school, Rocket Block for 180 minutes per week, teacher email and Google Classroom correspondence, and before or after school check-ins. With these efforts in place I can confidently say that we are balancing the competing forces of addressing the learning loss due to COVID-19 and helping our students progress through a more normalized cadence to a full school year. Once again, we ask that you softly and clearly reinforce self-advocacy skills with your child/ren to help address their needs with our staff--who cares for them more than any other I've encountered in the seven other institutions I've experienced.
