The date, time, and place are posted and announced as far in advance as possible and in accordance with state law.

Opinions and ideas contributed by students, parents/guardians, staff, and other citizens are valuable to the School Board. We have set aside time during the regular meeting time for "Recognition of Visitors and Public Forum." Anyone who is a resident of Independent School District #745 may address the Board on any topic during this time using the following guidelines:

- If you wish to address the School Board, please call the Superintendent's Office at 320-845-2171 ext. 5100. Give your name and home address as well as the topic of your comments. If you cannot call ahead of time, you may still be heard if time permits.
- The agenda is open to visitors of the meeting to offer comments to and/or requests of the School Board. The comments and requests should follow the adopted district guidelines which are printed and available at the meeting. As a general rule, items introduced in the opportunity for comments and requests do not receive action from the School Board, but are taken under advisement or consideration for future action.
- Please limit comments to five minutes.
- If you are not heard due to lack of time, you will be scheduled to present before the next regular Board meeting.
- Groups wishing to address the Board should do so through a single speakers.
- Matters currently under negotiation or litigation, or related to personnel, will not be discussed in public.
- Personal attacks are not permitted.
- You should use the appropriate administrative channels for addressing operational matters and address such concerns to the Board only if they go unresolved.
- The Board may respond or clarify immediately following a speaker. However, some issues
 require research and deliberation before an appropriate response can be made. If a full
 response is desired, particularly for complex issues, a letter of request to the Board is
 recommended with questions or concerns clearly stated.
