



## Dual Credit Placement Requirements

To enroll in dual credit classes, you must meet placement qualifications. You can do this with qualifying ACT (American College Testing) or Accuplacer scores. If you have qualifying ACT scores, you do not need to take the Accuplacer. Scores must be less than three years old.

### Initial Eligibility Requirements

Seniors*	Cumulative Unweighted GPA of 2.5 or above
Juniors	
Sophomores	Cumulative Unweighted GPA of 3.0 or above

\*Seniors with a cumulative 7<sup>th</sup> semester, **unweighted GPA of:**

- **3.0** or higher automatically qualify for Comp & Read and/or Speech.
- **3.30** or higher automatically qualify for College Algebra.

All other dual credit classes	Reading	18

<sup>^</sup> Students with an AP Score of 3 or higher on AP English Language & Composition can receive credit for ENGL 101 and do not need to complete reading or writing placement.

If you have previously taken the ACCUPLACER and qualified based upon those score(s) you do not need to retest in those areas.
