

Last fiscal year, the contributors below donated \$41,000 to the Infinity Fund Endowment. This endowment was created in 2016 to provide long-term, secure funding for financial aid, the recruitment and retention of excellent teachers, and school programs. Its market value, as of June 30, 2020, was \$8.3 million.

The SCDS Board of Trustees determines on an annual basis how much, if any, of the endowment's income will be used for the purposes stated above. At this time, as determined by the SCDS Board of Trustees, the endowment will remain in a building phase. Our thanks to the contributors below for their investment in tomorrow's students.
