

Located 38 miles northwest of Chicago, Lake Zurich Community Unit School District 95 encompasses an area of 19.4 square miles and serves the communities of Lake Zurich, Deer Park, Hawthorn Woods, Kildeer, unincorporated Lake County, and North Barrington. In addition to a comprehensive instructional program, various extra–curricular activities such as sports, clubs, and fine arts are available to students. A full complement of services is provided in reading, differing abilities, speech services, English Learner (EL) and gifted education for those students who qualify.
