Charity Week 13 – 17 December 2021

This year our annual 'Charity Week', where the Sixth Form students raise money for their chosen charities, will take place the week beginning Monday 13th December 2020. Over the past 5 years, Sixth Form students have raised in excess of £20,000 for various local and national charities and we hope to continue to support those who need it.

Sixth Form students are raising money this year for Dogs for Good and Samaritans by running a break time tuck shop, hosting lunchtime events for each year group featuring their subject teachers and performing a pantomime style show across the final two days of term.

Students will each be able to attend 1 lunch time event on the designated day for their year group, these are:

Monday	Strictly Come Dancing: Year 7
Tuesday	Family Fortunes: Year 9
Tuesday	Lip Sync Battle: Year 10
Wednesday	Task Master: Year 11
Wednesday	Task Master: Year 8

Students will also be able to purchase a range of sweets, drinks and snacks at break time throughout the week – the cost of these items will range from 50p to £2.00. Students will need to bring change with them if they wish to visit the tuck shop. Please do not send in monetary notes.

During the last two days of term Sixth Form students will be performing their annual Charity Show to each year group. This show, written and directed by students themselves, is a memorable experience for our student community whilst also raising money for the chosen charities. To ensure both the lunch time events and show performances are as safe as possible we will be ensuring students attend in year group bubbles and that they wear a face covering in addition to spacing out chairs where possible and ensuring good ventilation.

Finally, students will be able to wear their Christmas jumpers or festive accessories with their full uniform on Friday 17th December. This is not a non-uniform day and students are still expected in correct skirts, trousers and shoes alongside their Christmas jumpers.

We are asking for a voluntary donation of £3.50 from each student towards our chosen charities via Parentpay in return for these fantastic and memorable experiences.
