School Nurse: Substitute Position

Skills necessary include:

- Candidates must be licensed as a Registered Nurse in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with experience working with young adults
- Bachelor's degree and a minimum of two years experience required, preferably in a school health office
- Ability to originate, update, and/or monitor health care, maintain records, and implement the coordinated school health program and Standing Orders
- Current CPR and First Aid certifications
- Strong interpersonal skills to work effectively with a diverse group of people including students, parents, and faculty. Calm and helpful manner with all constituencies; friendly and approachable style
- Computer literacy
- Documentation and record keeping knowledge and follow-through
- Excellent written and oral communication skills; good listener
