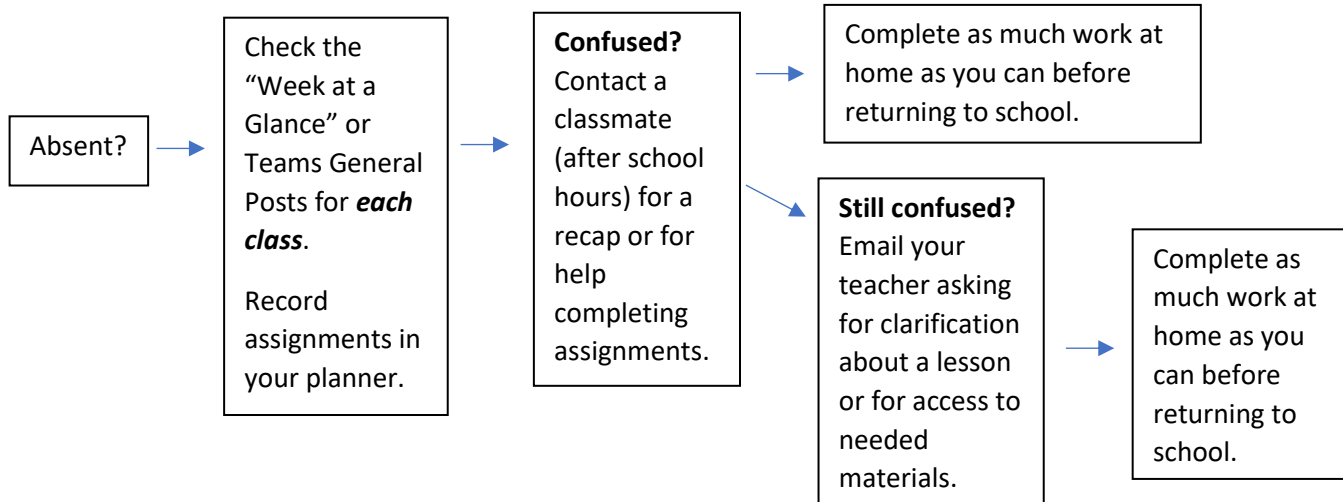


EAS Homework Guide
