Tulsans have made a five-year \$414 million investment in safe and accessible schools; state-of-the-art educational technology; sustainable student transportation; and rigorous, engaging, and culturally sustaining learning experiences that prepare students for success in college and careers.

At Webster High School, the 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools includes:

- » Replacing the athletic turf, waterproofing the stadium, and installing a new field house sound system.
- » Creating a new band/orchestra addition, providing designated space for students to participate in music programs;
- » Expanding and modernizing the school's agricultural education program with a state-of-the-art aquaponic and hydroponic greenhouse facility;
- » Remodeling for the school's science labs and investing in STEM equipment;
- » Refreshing the auditorium with upgraded lighting and sound systems, repainting, and installing new stage curtains;
- » Funding ADA-accessibility improvements in school restrooms and at building exits; and
- » Parking lot resurfacing and improvements to exterior lighting.
