Denver JDS students rely on exceptional teachers, a cutting-edge and challenging curriculum, and sophisticated, modern facilities, like our popular maker-spaces.

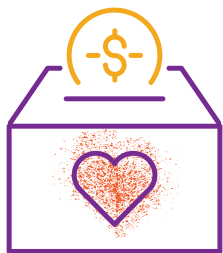
