PUBLIC NOTICE

Due to the current stay-at-home order for all Pennsylvanians, declared by Governor Wolf by Proclamation dated April 1, 2020, and the subsequent Executive Order closing schools through indefinitely, and in consideration of the health and safety of the school community, notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors (the “Board”) of the Lampeter-Strasburg School District (the “District”) shall hold regularly scheduled Board meetings in a virtual manner. Public participation shall be limited to remote connection using a virtual meeting platform to allow for connection by any member of the public and provide a mechanism for participants to indicate that they would like to speak and offer comments during the public comment portion of the meeting. Directions for connection to and participation in the public meetings will be published on the District’s publicly accessible website. A recording of the meeting will be kept until the meeting minutes are approved by the board at a subsequent meeting. The Board reserves the right to entertain any and all such matters that may be properly brought before the Board during these meetings.
