

STUDENT DRIVING & PARKING AGREEMENT 2018-2019

MOT Charter School has adopted the following procedures and regulations regarding student driving and parking at the MOT Charter School High School Campus. Driving to school is a privilege and failure to follow the procedures and regulations outlined in this agreement may result in the revocation of campus driving and parking privileges.

PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Student drivers must follow all applicable state and local traffic laws, as well as all MOT Charter School driving and parking regulations, at all times. Speeding or unsafe driving will result in revocation of the parking permit and loss of driving privilege.
- 2. Parking permits may not be transferred to other students or vehicles. Permits are valid for the registered driver and vehicle(s) listed on this form only. Parking permits MUST be displayed in the vehicle, hanging from the rearview mirror so that the number can be viewed from the outside, at all times. If your tag is lost or stolen, please notify the front desk. Tags are \$30.00 Replacement tags cost \$10.00.
- 3. Only registered student vehicles may be driven to school and parked on campus.
- 4. Registered student vehicles may only be parked **in their assigned spot** in the student parking area, located behind the school building. Do not leave vehicles in any other parking areas, in fire lanes, handicapped parking spaces, along curbs, or on the grass.
- 5. Vehicles may not be left on campus beyond the duration of school-sponsored events, overnight, on weekends, or on holidays.
- 6. Students may not access their vehicles during the academic day without direct approval from the front office or a school administrator.
- 7. Students receiving a parking permit understand that they will not be included in the bus route planning process and will need to contact the front office immediately if at any time throughout the year they wish to relinquish their parking spot and be placed on a bus route.
- 8. Cars parked on school property are subject to the Search & Seizure laws of the State of Delaware, State Board, and all MOT Charter School policies.
- 9. Student vehicles not parked in their assigned spot, or vehicles parked on campus without a displayed parking permit, are subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- 10. Students must provide a valid Delaware driver's license and proof of insurance to acquire their parking pass.
- 11. For maintenance of timely bus runs, at dismissal, students must wait until after buses dismiss before leaving the parking lot.
