Uniform Dress Code

The following uniform dress code is required for all Clear Path students. Students out of dress code as described below at the beginning of the day must call home to have their dress corrected. If the dress code can not be corrected appropriately, the student must return home for the day.

Pants: Black, Tan or Navy Blue-colored school uniform style pants

- Pants must be properly sized, belted at the waist, with belt loops, and in good repair
- Corduroy and jeans material pants are not allowed
- Pants may not be worn over-sized or baggy
- No cargo, capri style pants, skinny pants, joggers, jeggings or shorts
- No thermal underwear, shorts, or other outerwear may be worn under the dress code pants
- **All pockets must be able to be pulled out.**

Shirt: All White, button-down dress shirt, with functioning top button

- Shirts must be appropriately sized for males and females. Tight fitting shirts are not allowed
- Shirts must be tucked in the pants without any “blousing” and should be neat in appearance
- Shirts that are too short to be tucked in will not be allowed
- Short sleeves may be worn provided no tattoos or other markings are visible.
- Students should wear a plain, white t-shirt (undershirt) under their uniform shirt
- Logos more than 1” in diameter on shirts are not allowed
- Students on Green may wear a long or short-sleeved, plain polo-style shirt, with a logo no larger than 1” x 1” in diameter

Tie: Students on Orange, Red, and Blue are required to wear a school-provided tie while on campus.

- Students pick up the tie on their way into the building in the morning and deposit the tie in a bin on their way out in the afternoon.

Belt: 1” – 2” Black or brown traditional belt with traditional buckle. No decorations or perforations allowed.

Shoes: Solid black or white tennis, athletic or Van styled shoes only.

- Shoelaces will be white or black to match the shoe, no other color is acceptable.

Socks: Solid color white or black socks only.

Sweatshirt: A solid white, black, or gray pullover sweatshirt or sweater may be worn

- No hood or pockets allowed on the pullover
- Pullover must be worn properly and must be worn during the entire school day

Tattoos: No tattoos, writing, or markings of any kind may be visible on the skin.

- Tattoos that cannot be covered by clothing must be covered with bandages/Band-Aids PRIOR to arriving on campus.
- Larger tattoos can be covered with an ACE bandage or KT tape. These items are not available on campus and must be addressed at home prior to entering the building.

Hair: Hair must be a natural hair color, kept clean, conventionally styled and non-distracting

- Hair must be cut or pulled back out of the student’s face
- Patterns and/or designs may not be shaved into the hair
- No hair accessories of any kind may be used except a plain rubber-band type ponytail holder
 - This includes: “scrunchies”, hair clips and pins of any type.
- No beads or decorative accessories may be in braids or extensions

Jackets and coats: Are not to be worn in the building

- Jackets and coats will be placed in a designated area immediate upon entering the building and may not be removed until the end of the school day
- Jackets and coats with inappropriate advertisements, logos, etc., are not to be worn to school

Addition Dress Code Information:

- **Facial hair** - Students must be clean-shaven or display well-groomed facial hair each morning.
- **Head wear:** Hats, caps, bandanas, and other head apparel may not be worn and are not permitted.
- Absolutely **no jewelry** is permitted. This includes watches, earrings, rings, or pierced objects, etc. Band-aids or other materials may not be used to cover up jewelry.
- **Fingernail polish** or acrylic (fake) fingernails are not permitted
- **Eyelash extensions** are not permitted
