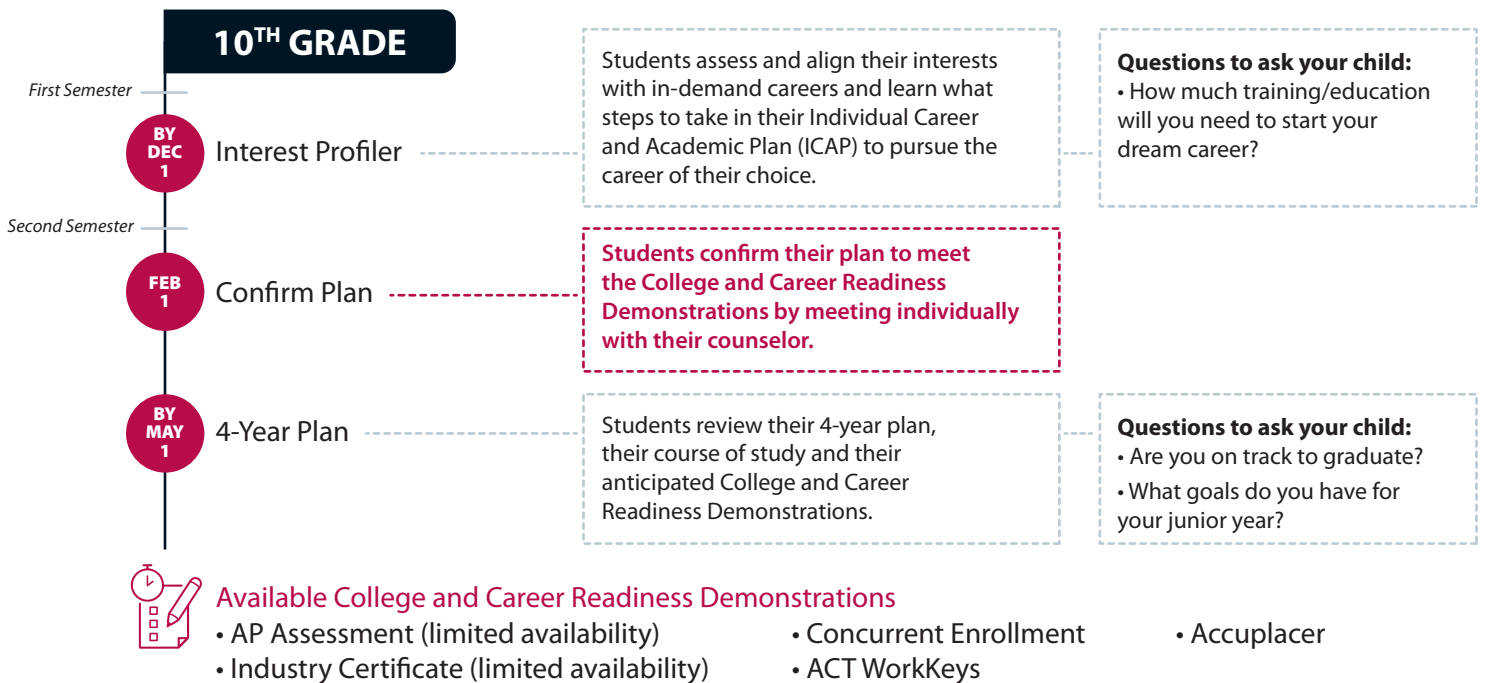
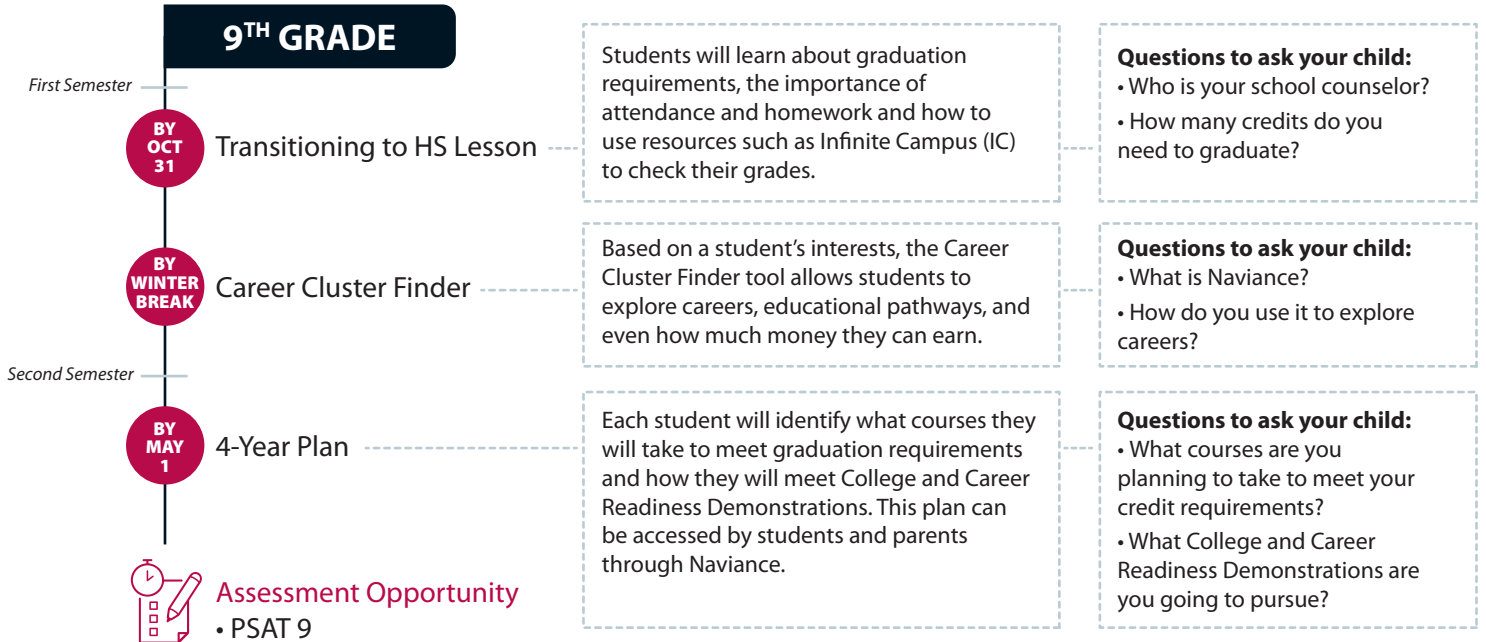


# High School Counseling Timeline
