Making improvements to the practice field used by our student athletes.

- » Redesigning the school's front entrance to provide a safe, welcoming, and secure student, parent, and visitor experience;
- » Funding repairs to the school's parking lot and sidewalks and improvements to exterior lighting;
- » Upgrading the auditorium lighting and sound system, and providing new stage curtains and seating; and
- » Remodeling the school's science labs and investing in STEM equipment.



TOTAL INVESTMENT IN EAST CENTRAL JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL: \$5 MILLION

PROPOSITION 1: SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS - \$1.3 MILLION

- » Security cameras and radios
- » Safe entry and door access control
- » Parking lot, sidewalk, and exterior LED lighting
- » School and classroom furniture

PROPOSITION 2: STUDENT AND CLASSROOM TECHNOLOGY - \$1.9 MILLION

- » Network and systems upgrades
- » Student and teacher technology

PROPOSITION 3: TRANSPORTATION

- » Funding from Proposition 3 will ensure that all students have access to safe, comfortable, and dependable transportation.

PROPOSITION 4: QUALITY LEARNING MATERIALS AND PROGRAMS - \$1.8 MILLION

- » Textbooks and learning materials
- » Fine arts and auditorium upgrades
- » Library digital and print resources
- » School projects funds
- » Wellness and physical education
