The 2021 Bond for Tulsa Public Schools will bring exciting changes to the Memorial High School community! The proposed package includes:



LaFortune Stadium turf replacement and waterproofing, replacement of the school's tennis court, and pool refresh work.

- » Redesigning the cafeteria into a flexible, comfortable, multi-use space for students, teachers, and support professionals;
- » Upgrades to the auditorium lighting and sound system and new stage curtains;
- » Remodels for the school's science labs and investments in STEM equipment;
- » Security enhancements at the school's main entrance;
- » ADA-accessibility improvements in school restrooms and at building exits;
- » Parking lot resurfacing and improvements to exterior lighting; and
- » Repairing and upgrading the HVAC system federally funded by the CARES Act.



TOTAL INVESTMENT IN MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL: \$13.1 MILLION

PROPOSITION 1: SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS - \$6.6 MILLION

- » Fire and security alarms
- » Security cameras and radios
- » Safe entry and door access control
- » Accessibility building improvements
- » Parking lot, sidewalk, and exterior LED lighting
- » Dining/kitchen improvements
- » School and classroom furniture

PROPOSITION 2: STUDENT AND CLASSROOM TECHNOLOGY - \$2.4 MILLION

- » Network and systems upgrades
- » Student and teacher technology

PROPOSITION 3: TRANSPORTATION

- » Funding from Proposition 3 will ensure that all students have access to safe, comfortable, and dependable transportation.

PROPOSITION 4: QUALITY LEARNING MATERIALS AND PROGRAMS - \$4.1 MILLION

- » Textbooks and learning materials
- » Fine arts and auditorium upgrades
- » Library digital and print resources
- » School projects funds
- » Wellness and physical education
