RAINBOW READER

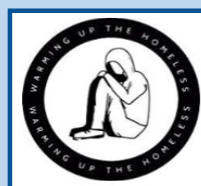
A big well done to Rita in Class Rhino who has achieved her Rainbow Reader Certificate. We look forward to sharing more Rainbow Readers with you next term.

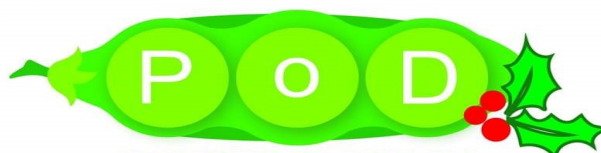
