1. Call to Order **4:30pm**
2. Consideration, discussion, and possible approval of the 2022-2027 District of Innovation for submission to Board of Trustees (Action item)

Everything is the same we have used in the past except the new item we added about conference times. We are discussing this matter again today as a public meeting. All committee members voted in favor of moving forward with taking the new DOI to the school board in January. There was no public comment.

3. 2022-2023 Calendar Drafts / Survey (Information item)

Calendar drafts A-F were given to committee members. Dr. Pitts explained each one. Calendar A is similar to what we have adopted for this year. Calendar B has an additional week off for a fall break in October. Calendar C has an additional week off for a break at the end of January through the beginning of February. Calendar D has an adjusted winter break so staff will not return to work until January 9 and the semester ends in January. Calendar E has the additional fall break in October and the adjusted winter break to return on January 9. Calendar F starts school on August 17 and has the adjusted winter break to return on January 9.

A CAT Committee Survey about the calendar was given for all committee members to fill out and return during the meeting.

Title I funding is money we get for low income families and can either be targeted or school-wide. If the campus does not exceed 40%, there must be a waiver in order to use these funds. The elementary campus reached 40% this fall and the ED-FLEX Waiver is no longer necessary.

We intend to submit the ED-FLEX Waiver next year for the new elementary campus. If we are validated, there must be documentation provided as to why the campus needs the funds through the waiver.

5. Results Driven Accountability (RDA)

This accountability is specifically related to special education services and other special programs. There is no level determination of 0; 1 is the best level you can receive. The district scored a level determination of 1 in all areas. There will be a formal report to the board in January.

6. Formative Assessment of District Improvement Plan (Information item)

The District Improvement Plan was discussed to share the formative assessment of specific information. SB 9 required districts to put dating violence information in the DIP and it has been added to ours. The Social Service Liaison has been hired and has created a new page on the website for resources. There is information addressed in the plan about links on the website to provide a way to communicate about dating violence. There is also information in the DIP about Accelerated Instruction that is required by HB 4545.

Parent information sessions will start in January 2022.
