RLO discussion:

- Feedback from the school board; Parents will appreciate it if there is some more interaction and some check-ins with zoom. Administration plan on offering QDL to students who are quarantined by the Health Department. We are working on a plan for each grade level
- [QDL Guidelines](#)
- Quarantine Distance Learning (QDL) is for students with an extended absence of three or more days due to quarantine requirements by the health department.

- Once a quarantine is reported to the office or mandated by the health department due to exposure at school, the teachers have 24 hours to set up a student for QDL.
- QDL is optional for the student to participate. If a student will not participate, as a courtesy, parents are asked to communicate this to the student's homeroom teacher.
- Completing and turning in assignments will count a student as present for attendance.
- Expectations by grade level:
 - Kindergarten- 1st grade: Offer Zoom one time per day and check-in meetings as needed
 - 2nd-3rd grade: Offer Zoom for reading and math, independent assignments for other subjects
 - 4th grade: Offer Zooms three times per day with core subject teachers
 - 5th-8th grade: Offer Zooms six times per day with core subject teachers
 - Uniques: work depends on subject area

Technology: School board will review the technology plan next month (October meeting)

The Student Council President will be voted in soon and will start attending School Board meetings in the next few months.

Father Jason: Altar serving training for grades 3-8 has been successful. He is excited about having the students get involved in more ministries of the church. He also has been training some junior high students to help with the live streaming of mass.
