Senator Nelson,

Hope you are having a great week. As I've followed HB 1525, I have engaged your office several times about providing lost funding for Northwest ISD because of HB 3. I see the Senate might be voting on the cleanup bill (CSHB 1525) as early as today, and please know I have real concerns on its effects on NISD. We have looked at financial runs from the LBB, the Fast-Growth School Coalition, and the Texas School Coalition, and those runs either show no positive improvements for our revenue challenges, and some show further reductions in our revenue for the next biennium. I respectfully request that you do not vote for the cleanup bill until we know that the district, and other districts similar to Northwest, will be positively affected by the new law.

I truly appreciate your efforts as you represent our children.
