Construction Updates

Every day brings new and exciting views during recess as the building is being constructed. Here are some updates and pictures. Thank you for your patience as we continue to grow.

This week, the contractor topped out the steel at the expansion, and installed the metal roof decking. Steel workers are expected to be complete and off site by the end of this week. The contractor is also working on completing the building drainage system around the perimeter of the expansion area and preparing to tie the new steel into the existing building. They are targeting the concrete floor pour to occur before the end of December.

You may return to work/school and not quarantine within a few days of vaccine administration, IF:

- You HAVE NOT been in contact with someone with COVID-19 AND
- You feel well enough and are willing to perform normal activities such as work or school AND
- You do not have a fever AND
- Symptoms are LIMITED ONLY to those observed following COVID-19 vaccination: Pain, Redness, Swelling, Fatigue, Muscle Aches, Diarrhea, Nausea, or Headache.
