ABOUT US

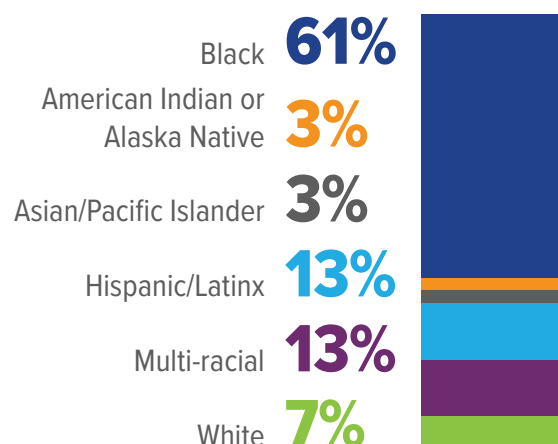

PARENT INVOLVEMENT

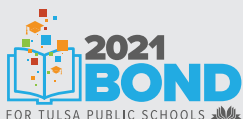
