### LEADERSHIP LEARNING

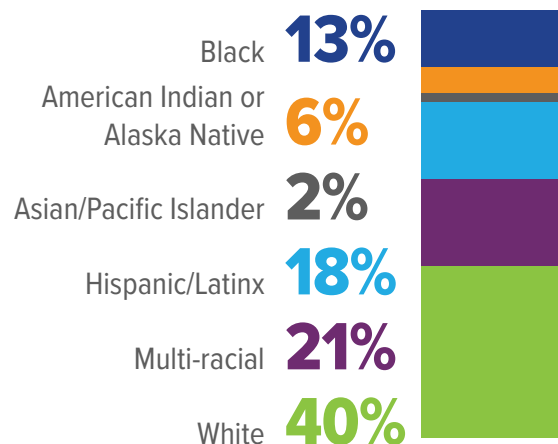

## STEM PROGRAMMING

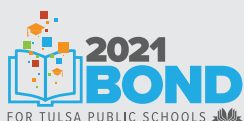
