Program Requirements

Title 1 Action Plan

Title I of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA/ESEA) is a federal funding program designed to close achievement gaps and ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education.

Academic Assessments

- All students K-5 are administered our universal screener FastBridge - 3 times a year (fall, winter, spring)
- Data is analyzed in grade level PLC's by classroom teachers and specialists (Title & EL) to determine if students are in need of additional support
- W.I.N. - data reviewed monthly and/or after each screening window

Progress Monitoring

- Students identified with skill deficiencies are monitored weekly to ensure they are effectively responding to intervention support
- Students not responding may be referred to our Response to Intervention team for additional problem solving recommendations
- Families notified via signed letter if their child will receive supports and in what area

School-Wide SLO

- Our SLO goal for 2021-22 is to have 84% of K&1, FAY students scoring in the 40%ile or higher, in Early Math composite. This is an increase of 10%.
- Our SLO goal for 2021-22 is to have 60% of all 2nd - 5th grade, FAY students scoring in the 40%ile or higher, in aMath. This is an increase of 16%
- Forward Exam in the Spring of 2021 showed 39% of 3rd-5th graders scoring in Proficient or Advanced in ELA
- Forward Exam in the Spring of 2021 showed 27.9% of 3rd-5th graders scoring Proficient or Advanced in Math
