CURRICULUM COVERAGE

English

This term, Year 2 will be taking to the skies on an epic flying adventure. Here's a birds eye view of some of the texts we will be using to support the children's learning. Emma Jane zooms off in her aeroplane around the cities of the world in 'Emma Jane's aeroplane' by Katie Haworth and Daniel Rieley. Along the way she makes a crew of animal friends who save the day when the little plane gets into trouble. The children will be looking at the way the author has used a rhyming narrative effectively and delving into the characters and creating their very own to join Emma on her adventures. This tale is perfect for inspiring little explorers everywhere! We will also be learning about Amelia Earhart using the 'little people, big dreams' series. The book follows Amelia Earhart, whose strong will and self-belief helped her overcome prejudice and technical problems to become the first female flier to fly solo across the Atlantic ocean. This inspiring and informative little biography is filled with plenty of facts to support writing opportunities

Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on Multiplication and Division. We will be using lots of visual and practical resources such as arrays to support our understanding and learning lots of different strategies that we can use. We will be continuing to count in multiples of 2, 5, 10 and 3 and applying our learning to help us solve problems involving multiplying and dividing money and measures.
