

Public Performances by Students

The Bethany Board of Education (Board) recognizes the educational value from student participation in civic and community events. Teachers are encouraged to prepare students for public performances which contribute to student education when they don't interfere unduly with other educational activities or programs.

At least once a year all parents/guardians will be notified that photos, videos, or recording of students may appear on the Bethany Public School District (District) website or in local publications. Parents who do not want their student interviewed, photographed, or videotaped by the media shall inform the school administration accordingly. Parents/guardians who do not want their student interviewed or photographed or videotaped by the media should direct their child accordingly.

School groups may participate in local public events as authorized by Administrative Regulations.

The District will comply with Board Policies and Administrative Regulations related to providing media access to students.
