

Criminal Justice Information

All applicants considered for a position with the Bethany Public School District (District), as well as, volunteers, in accordance with Bethany Board of Education (Board) Policy and Administrative Regulation, shall be required to submit to state and national criminal record checks in accordance with Board policy, administrative regulations, and laws. All results and accompanying information shall be considered “Criminal Justice Information” (CJI). The Board directs the Superintendent to establish administrative regulations to provide minimum security requirements associated with the creation, viewing, modification, transmission, dissemination, storage, or destruction of CJI.
