

Administration of Student Medications in School

It is the policy of the Bethany Board of Education (Board) to determine who shall administer medications in the school and the circumstances under which self-administration of medication by students shall be permitted.

The Board allows students to self-administer medication and school personnel to administer medication to students in accordance with the established procedures, and applicable state laws and regulations. In order to provide immunity afforded to school personnel who administer medication, the Board directs the Superintendent to promulgate Administrative Regulations, with the advice and approval of the District Medical Advisor and shall review and/or revise the Administrative Regulation biennially concerning the administration of medications to District students by a nurse, or in the absence of a nurse, by qualified personnel for schools.
