

**Energy-Conserving Construction**

The Bethany Board of Education (Board) recognizes the importance and need for energy conservation in the construction of new school facilities or renovation of existing facilities. Further, all new school construction and renovation projects shall consider means to maximize natural light.

Proposed construction and renovation projects that contain the most efficient energy-saving plans within an acceptable budget will have high priority. Energy-saving designs will be documented in the architectural evaluation and will comply with educational specifications and cost control checklists as determined by the Board.

A continuous review of energy problems and energy sources will be maintained for future planning.
