

A new law requires Illinois Driver's License applicants ages 18, 19, or 20, who have never previously been licensed or completed an approved driver education course, to complete a six-hour Adult Driver Education Course.

The Adult Driver Education Course can only be taught by providers certified by the Secretary of State. Courses may be taught in a classroom setting or online, depending on the certification of a provider. Completion of an Adult Driver Education Course from a provider NOT LISTED, will not be accepted.

To enroll in a class, follow these instructions:

Upon successful completion of this course a "Certificate of Completion" will be provided to you and then you may visit a Secretary of State Driver Services facility to complete your vision, written and road test.

### **Permit Information**

Students who are 17 years old and 3 months may obtain a permit at the DMV even if they are NOT enrolled in a Driver's Education Course. Students will need their Birth Certificate, Social Security Card and \$20.
