While we continue to Press On, we are happy to share with you some of the other notable moments that remind us that we remain committed and focused on our school's mission:

- HBA won second place in *Pacific Business News'* Hawaii's Best Workplaces of 2021;
- The Elementary Campus expanded its offerings to include a Junior Kindergarten program;
- *Eagle Eye* newspaper won Best-In-State for the seventh consecutive year;
- HBA's Elementary School set a new giving record for the American Heart Association by raising more than \$34,000 through the Kids Heart Challenge;

- Adia Ainsworth ('21) was named a National Merit Scholar and received a college-sponsored scholarship for academic achievements representing the top 1% of the country;
- Marisa Tonaki ('21) had two films selected for screening at the Hawaii International Film Festival, an animation titled *Bam Bam Crash!* and live action drama *Perfect*;
- Brendan Aoki ('24) had his live action drama *Footprint* selected for screening at the Hawaii International Film Festival;
- Intro to Animation class taught by Garrett Omoto had their compilation film selected for screening at the Hawaii International Film Festival;
- Band, Wind Ensemble, Choir, and Theater hosted virtual performances;
- The Hawaii Baptist Academy Arts and Film Festival (HBAFF) was hosted online for the second year in a row for each of our campuses. Artwork & films can still be viewed at hbaaff.hba.net;
- HBA's Elementary Campus raised more than \$300 for books for Ka Pa'alana Preschool for homeless children;
- In partnership with Kaiser Permanente, HBA hosted community-wide COVID vaccination and booster clinics;
- HBA's Middle School raised \$14,644 for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society through various service projects.

While the future remains uncertain, what remains certain is that God is always here for us. He has always guided us and shown us a pathway forward. For more than 70 years, we have grown from graduating the first class of three students to serving more than 1,000 annually. Our students have grown into many leadership positions in service to their communities, and that is something that can serve as a beacon of light in dark times. 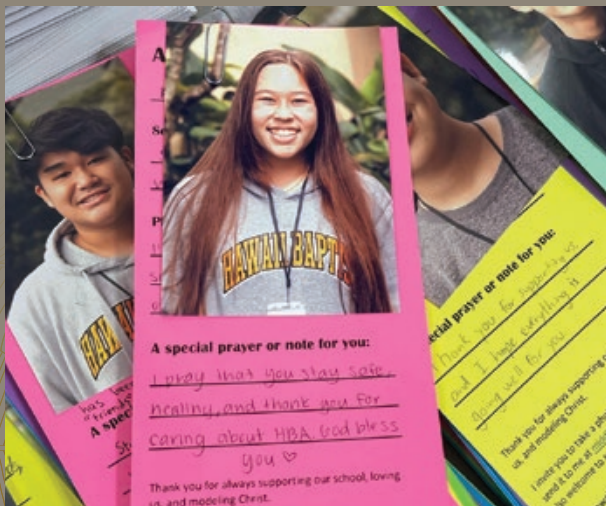

The Eagles Kokua Fund was launched in May 2020 to provide additional tuition assistance to families who have faced significant hardships due to COVID-19. Since its inception, the school has raised over \$97,000 thanks to generous supporters, families, and students, allowing the school to help 62 families for the 2020-2021 school year.

Throughout this year, we have witnessed numerous student-led efforts to support this fund. For example, the National Honor Society's (NHS) fundraising sub-committee raised \$2,802.28 from their annual Christmas wreath sale.

"We hope our donation will help alleviate the burden of paying for tuition during a stressful time so that these families' students can be equipped with the tools they need to succeed while at HBA and beyond," shares NHS fundraising co-chairs Aimee-Louise Lee '21 and Kellie Takai '21.

Two sophomores used their new found hobby to help others during this pandemic. In the summer of 2020, Lauren Toda and Noelle Nagaishi took up sewing to pass the time while they were isolated at home. As they progressed in their skills, they started sewing face masks in response to the global health crisis. They then set up a virtual storefront on Etsy to sell their face masks in an effort to help their classmates who have been financially impacted by the pandemic.



"We love our school and didn't want to see any of our classmates leave due to financial hardships because of COVID. After learning about the Eagles Kokua Fund, we decided that the net proceeds from the sale of the masks would be given to this fund," said Toda.

The girls sold 232 masks which raised \$2,270 towards the Eagles Kokua Fund, including a donor matched monetary gift.

St. Francis Healthcare System donated \$500 to the Eagles Kokua Fund thanks to the hard work of HBA Interact members who participated in the 8th Annual Saint Marianne Cope Walk and Wellness Fair in January. As part of the requirement, the students created a wellness event by organizing a virtual walk on Google Meet so they could

participate from the safety of their homes. They also submitted one minute videos about the importance their grandparents have in their lives. All three student video submissions from HBA were shown during the Saint Marianne Cope Walk and Wellness Fair closing ceremony video.

"We sincerely appreciate St. Francis Healthcare System's generosity towards our families. This is a great example of how organizations in our community are able to help one another, especially during these difficult times. It was also a joy to witness our students practice their leadership skills as they organized their virtual activity in a matter of days, while bringing honor to their grandparents through video in this special way," shares President Ron Shiira '75. The Interact Club develops leadership skills while promoting the concept of service above self.

In addition to these efforts, an HBA alumna was so inspired after learning about the student-led efforts, that she created a \$3,000 matching challenge of her own to students of all three campuses to benefit the Eagles Kokua Fund. The elementary student council sold eagle face masks and candy grams for Valentine's Day, while the middle and high schools raised funds through various student challenges during Spirit Week. The combined efforts from the student body produced a total of \$4,500 towards the Eagles Kokua Fund.

Hawaii Baptist Academy is inspired by our students and their efforts to show love and compassion to their classmates through these kind and selfless acts. They are exemplary models of leading a life of service.

Celebrating A Life Through Scholarship

Ruby Fumiko Sakoda Nakahara had a zest for life, a curiosity to learn, and a passion for teaching. The former educator died on February 3, 2021, due to complications from COVID-19 at the age of 85. However, her legacy will live on through a new scholarship endowment that was established by her husband, Masaru Nakahara.



Born in Honolulu, in 1937, Ruby attended Hawaii Baptist Academy from middle school through her sophomore year, later graduating from McKinley High School in 1955.

“Ruby was always popular in school, often being selected to represent her class to speak at school functions,” shares



Mr. Nakahara. “Although Ruby did not graduate from HBA she had fond memories of her time at the Baptist school.”

After high school, Ruby attended the University of Hawaii and earned a master’s degree in chemistry as well as her teaching credential.

After teaching at Kaimuki High School from 1961 to 1964, she moved to California and taught at Palo Alto High School. To further her education, she attended Oregon State University in Corvallis on a scholarship and earned her second master’s degree. Ruby then returned to teaching in

Palo Alto until she accepted a position with the US Army in Kaiserslautern, Germany, where she taught military dependent children at the high school level. While in Germany she met her future husband, Masaru, an engineer with Hughes Aircraft. They were married in Basil, Switzerland, in 1970. They later returned to the United States and lived in Massachusetts for a year before making their home in Fullerton, California.

In memory of his wife, Masaru established a scholarship endowment called the Ruby S. Nakahara Scholarship to benefit students at HBA who have financial need and demonstrate a desire to work hard and have a willingness to learn.

On June 17, 2021, a celebration of life was held in Honolulu in which HBA alumna Sophie Hepton ’21 shared a vocal rendition of “Blessings” by Laura Story, while Tiffany Hamada ’21 dedicated a beautiful hula in memory of Mrs. Nakahara.

The song featured guest artist Christopher Kale Jones '96, a professional singer and actor based in Chicago. Jones is best known for his role as Frankie Valli in the first national tour of the Broadway hit "Jersey Boys."



"The community of alumni participating came together from all walks of life—college students to physicians, flight attendants to social workers, even folks who are unemployed due to COVID-19," said Billie Takaki Lueder '94, director of institutional advancement. "We are grateful to our alumni for taking the time to lend their talents, providing encouragement and hope through worship."

The song was featured on the HBA Alumni Facebook and Instagram platforms, and on the school's YouTube channel.

We Can Do This!

Sharon Kim '09 didn't originally plan on becoming a business owner, but after experiencing a personal need for a niche product, she launched CanPlan.

"When my mom was diagnosed with cancer, I became her main caregiver. I really believe that God was using the pain of watching my mom go through cancer in order to deepen my purpose. I realized there was a huge unmet need in the cancer community, and I didn't want to see other families struggle with the same type of issues my family and I struggled with. The idea of CanPlan was birthed from seeing and experiencing a genuine need, and feeling the call to address it," said Kim.

CanPlan is a planner specifically designed with survivorship in mind. It was created in order to reinstate a sense of control for cancer patients and their caregivers by providing them with the tools to track and analyze their health.

"Since CanPlan was such a novel idea, I really wanted to get a group of users to adopt the habit of tracking their health and sharing their findings with one another. I wanted the community to be at the center of CanPlan, so that we can all work together towards finding potential healing remedies," shares Kim.

Kim, who is a daughter of HBA, says she is grateful for the support she received from her teachers because they helped her to build a firm foundation in her relationship with Christ. One teacher who was an important mentor was Tony Traugher, Bible department chair. She appreciated his openness as he encouraged students to "come as they are" to learn more about Jesus.

Legacy Planning for Kingdom Building

Hawaii Baptist Academy, in partnership with the Hawaii Baptist Foundation, sponsored a virtual gift and estate planning seminar in November 2020 that included special guest speaker, Sharon Kim '09, creator of CanPlan.

Participants learned about options to plan for the future to make a significant difference in the lives of our students for generations to come. A planned gift is one that comes from sources other than a person's current expendable income and is based on total assets. It is generally part of a total estate plan and may take effect during the donor's life or after death. Because every person's financial and charitable objectives differ, a plan should be customized to meet one's specific needs. Each person should explore their planned giving options by working with a qualified attorney, certified financial planner, or other professional financial planner.

Fundraising for capital and operational needs is ongoing. Since tuition covers only about 80% of the school's operating budget, the remaining 20% and all capital funds required for buildings are raised through the generous gifts from supporters.

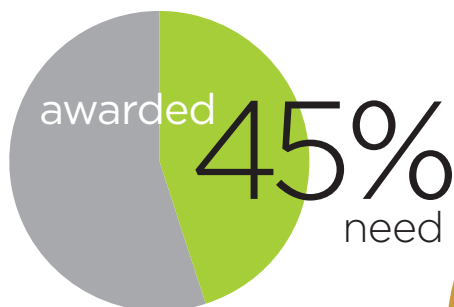

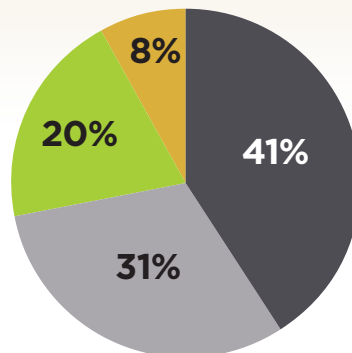
